#3 Sightseeing of Novi Sad by car 4h

Explore Novi Sad on foot and by bus or a car, in a panoramic sightseeing. Start the walk in the city center, from Serbian National Theatre, across the Main City Square, with a stop to admire the beautiful architecture of many houses and sacral buildings like the Catholic Church, Catholic Porte, Gathering Church and the Bishop's Court. Stroll the oldest streets in Novi Sad – Pasiceva Street, with the Library of Matica Srpska, Zmaj Jovina and Dunavska Street, that now leads to the beautiful piece of nature – Dunavski Park, but 250 years ago led straight to Danube River. Hop on the bus to take a ride and discover the busy streets of Novi Sad, pass by the house of Mileva Maric, the wife of Albert Einstein, the Railway Station, Boulevard of Freedom, Novi Sad pier walking area along the Danube River, and the beautiful sandy beach called Strand – a very popular place to escape from the summer heat in the city. Drive over the Rainbow Bridge, and up to the Petrovaradin Fortress – The Gibraltar on the Danube River. Wonder round the Petrovaradin Fortress, one of the best preserved fortresses in the world, with a stunning view over the city of Novi Sad and the Danube River. Enjoy a refreshing drink on one of the plateaus on the Petrovaradin Fortress.

Time of departure: Every day - ideal at 10 am,
- It can be changed if group wishes so

Place of departure: In front of city hall, on Sloboda Square

Reservations: one day ahead, until 10 am

Duration: four hours
