#13 DJERDAP TOUR

Two days tour - on request

During this trip, way leads you along the flow of Danube - the river that unites. Enjoy in beautiful view to Djerdap Cliff, also called The Iron Gate of Europe. This beautiful nature wonder is one of the biggest gorges in Europe trough which the ancient Panonian See has floated. You will visit Golubac, a town where Danube is 6 km wide and for that reason called "Serbian sea". Visit to the famous Golubac fortress, from the XIV century. Pre-historic archeological site of Lepenski Vir will also be seen. This Mesolithic archaeological site on the banks of the Danube River presents a settlement with around ten villages. Numerous sculptures and peculiar architecture are testimony to a rich social and religious life led by the inhabitants and the high cultural level of these early Europeans. Overnight in Kladovo town located on the right bank of the Danube River. Visit to Kucevo, town located on the 164m altitude. Short break. Departure to Ceremosnja Cave that represents one of the most beautiful caves in Serbia. It is explored, adapted and opened in 1980. This cave is located at the very bottom of Homolj Mountain, 15km from Kucevo. The overall length of the cave is 775.7m, while a path of 441m is adapted for the tourists. Lunch with the traditional cuisine near the cave.

Time of departure: Every day - ideal at 9 am,
- It can be changed if group wishes so

Place of departure: In front of your hotel

Reservations: one day ahead, until 10 am

Duration: two days

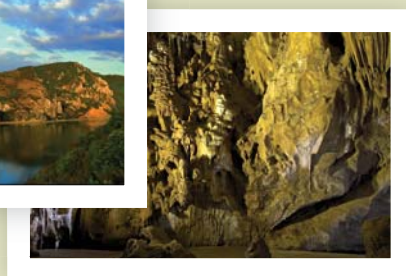
