Vojvodina Tour

Krusedol, Sremski Karlovci, Petrovaradin and Novi Sad

Guaranteed departure - (minimum 2 persons)

Departure from Belgrade from Nikole Pasica square, no.12. Arrival at Krusedol Monastery - It was founded by Vladika Maksim (Djordje Brankovic) and it is one of the most beautiful monasteries on Fruska Gora Mountain. The monastery's church is dedicated to one of many Orthodox saints and the walls are covered in frescoes from the second half of the 16th century.

Departure to Sremski Karlovci - small baroque town. Sightseeing of the most interesting place in the town including the Orthodox Church, the Patriarchy Court, the Theology School, the Grammar School. Visit to the wine-cellar including wine tasting (including Bermet - special desert wine which the town is famous for).



Continuing to Petrovaradin with stop for visiting Church at Tekije (Snezna Gospa). Sightseeing of Petrovaradin fortress, called the Gibraltar on the Danube. Petrovaradin fortress is one of the most famous fortress in Europe and it is situated on the right bank of Danube river. Free time for lunch in one of the restaurants on the fortress.

Departure to Novi Sad. Panoramic sightseeing of Novi Sad and departure to the city centre. Sightseeing tour of the Novi Sad major attractions, including a short walk in the pedestrian area and Trg Slobode (the main city square), the Cathedral, the Town Hall, Zmaj Jovina and Dunavska Street, the Orthodox Church. After sightseeing you will have lunch in a restaurant in Novi Sad. Afterwards you will have some free time for shopping, coffee break, individual activities...

Monastery Tour

Guaranteed departure - (minimum 2 persons)

Departure in front of the Hotel Putnik. Departure to Sremski Karlovci. A short visit to the church at Tekije and reminder of the last battle with the Turks in this region 1716. Arrival in Sremski Karlovci, a small baroque town which is significant in several ways, its history and the unique wines that are made here. Visiting the attractions in the center: "Four Lions" fountain, Seminary in Sremski Karlovci, Patriarchal Palace, the first Serbian high school, etc... Visit to the Cathedral Church. Visit one of the many wineries and tasting of 5 types of wines. Taste Italian and Rhine Riesling, Cabernet, Merlot and the most famous-Bermet. Visit the Chapel of Peace, where in the 1699 had been signed a peace treaty between the Christian Alliance (Austria, Prussia and Venice) and Ottoman (Turks) and for the first time in world diplomacy, a round table was used for negotiations.



Go to the monastery Krusedol (XVI century) - the most important monastery on Fruska Gora, which was founded by Bishop Maksim (Djordje Brankovic) with his mother Angelina. The monastery church is dedicated to the Annunciation and it is wonderfully painted - the oldest frescoes date from the mid-sixteenth century and they represent the most important Baroque paintings of the Serbs.

Next is the monastery Grgeteg which is specific because that is it is perhaps the only Serbian monastery that is not painted in frescoes. The monastery church is dedicated to Saint Nicholas. This monastery has one of the best copies of the Icons of the Mother of God Trojeručica from Hilandar on Athos.



Visit at least one more monastery in agreement with a group lunch or Fruska Gora or at the cards on the Danube. If desired it is possible to arrange a visit to one of the lakes in the Fruska gora, or one of the wine cellars in Banostor or Cerevic.

Return back to Novi Sad is scheduled at 18.00 h.
