In Vrsac you will take a tour through the city center and visit the cultural importance – Vrsac Tower, “Pharmacy on stairs” – museum and gallery with exhibition “from the history of health culture”, Orthodox church and Roman Catholic Church. Travel the “paths” of wine, and taste the best wines from the largest vineyards in Serbia, where culture, history and wine make a great unity. Visiting vineyards in Gudurica and Veliko Srediste, where you will be able to learn more about the history, origin and mode of production of this “drink of god” Also we will visit to the brewery „St. Nikola”, in authentic ambient of the oldest brewery on Balkan. On this tour, you will have a chance to discover Deliblato sands, the unique sandy area, and the most significant habitat for birds, in Europe. Have a lunch on a Homestead farm, on the Danube coast, where nature, food, hospitality and the ambient of the beautiful view of the Danube and the unspoiled nature, will leave you breathless.
